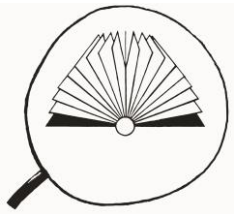

Monday to Friday - 9:00am to 3:00pm at the Simon Alaittuq School.**

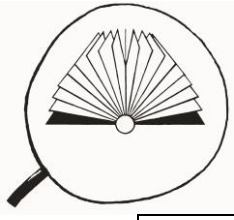
